Malaspina U-C Forest will be using RDN biosolids to fertilize forest stands on the private lands portion of its Woodlot Licence. The forest stands to be treated are in the Weigles Road area and numerous mountain bike trails are located in this area. Malaspina staff will try to minimize any negative impacts this project may have to mountain bike trails.
